Our Faith is Pandemic Proof

Let's see how we can grow in our faith in the midst of this pandemic by reflecting on some readings from James.

Meditate

James 1: 2-8 - Faith and Wisdom

² My brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of any kind, consider it nothing but joy, ³ because you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance; ⁴ and let endurance have its full effect, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking in nothing.

⁵ If any of you is lacking in wisdom, ask God, who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly, and it will be given you. ⁶ But ask in faith, never doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind; ^{7,8} for the doubter, being double-minded and unstable in every way, must not expect to receive anything from the Lord.

Questions for reflection

1. Name at least two good things that come out of trials and tribulations
2. If trials produce perseverance, what does perseverance produce?
3. How is perseverance important to Christian faith?
4. How does double-mindedness affect your perseverance?
5. Which verse in this passage do you find the most encouraging? Why?

James encourages praying for wisdom to get through times of trouble. Offer your own prayer for wisdom.

Building Reopening Update

I am reminded of the question heard from the back seat of cars during family road trips... "are we there yet?" Are we ready to reopen the building...soon. We now have Susan in the office, answering calls, and getting oriented to how the church functions and Rev. Sadekie has started. We want them to get settled, and develop safe practices working together.

Meanwhile, a small task group continues to develop protocols to insure everyone's safety as we slowly reopen. We now have a binder at the side door and are asking everyone to sign in as they enter. This will make contact tracing easier (should it be necessary). We have hand sanitizer stations at various points in the building. And we are working towards having small gatherings in the building (the number of people allowed in each space will be posted). In addition, we ask that anyone going into the OA office please sign in the Sign in Sheet in the holder on the door of the office.

This week, York Regional Council voted to make wearing face-covering inside public spaces a requirement **starting Friday, July 17, 2020, therefore we are asking everyone to wear a mask while in the building.** We are asking people bring their own, but will have some available on site soon.
