

“Children of Peace” Park



“Children of Peace Park” is located on the WEST side of Leslie St., south of Mount Albert/East Gwillimbury Civic Centre.

Park is paved, and accessible for strollers, walkers, wheelchairs, etc.



If walking from the parking lot of Sharon-Hope Church, follow the sidewalk heading north (left) on Leslie St. **NOTE: WALKING FROM THE CHURCH is approximately .72km one way.**

If driving from the church, one can park along paved shoulder of Leslie St., in front of the park.

Beginning at the **Leslie St. entrance** of the Children of Peace Park, **walk is approximately .55km.**

Follow the paved path, staying to the LEFT.

Continue to follow the LEFT path



.15km

Follow the curve to the RIGHT



.2km

Entrance to bridge with boardwalk



.25km

At the end of the bridge, you will see a bridge on your left. This is coming from the Sharon Creek Trail.

Remain on the "Children of Peace" paved path.



.3km

Veer to the path on the RIGHT.

Detour to the garden's white path with benches and enjoy the beauty while having a rest.



.35km

Continue across the garden to the adjacent paved path.



.4km

Another rest stop, a picnic shelter, is on your RIGHT.....



.43km

... and more benches at the end of the paved path.



.55km

Continue to follow paved path to the LEFT, with a slight incline, to head back to Leslie St.
